The Fiesta Days Committee is pleased to welcome you as a participant in the 40th Annual Arts and Crafts in the Park to be held on Saturday, July 16th in Veteran's Memorial Park (3400 Pearl Street, McHenry, IL 60050) from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm.

Please note the following about your participation:

Registration And Set Up: The registration table will be set up in the park by 6:00 am in front of the gazebo. Please check in upon arrival for the location of your designated area and unload your vehicle. Once vehicle is unloaded, move your vehicle prior to setting up. There are over 120 vendors, so please be patient while you are waiting to unload and efficient while you are unloading. All cars must be moved by 8:45am, when the street will be closed or **YOU WILL BE TOWED.**

Booth #(s): Available online at www.mchenryfiestadays.com on Thursday, July 14th or check in Saturday morning. There will also be a layout of the park at that time.

Exhibitor Parking: Parking will be on the grass area behind St. Mary's Church at the intersection of Route 31 and Pearl Street or one of the municipal parking lots. **There is no parking allowed on Pearl Street. There is also no parking in the handicapped area unless you have a handicapped sticker. (Tickets will be issued and vehicles will be towed).** Parking around the Veteran's Park is for patrons.

Facilities: Concessions and restroom facilities will be located in the park. Complimentary coffee and doughnuts will be available in the morning while supplies last.

Special Notes: Arts & Crafts in the Park is held rain or shine. There is no alternative site or rain date. It is extremely important that you be set-up by 9:00 am, our opening hour. It is not permitted to tear down prior to our closing hour of 4:00 pm.

For those of you who might need overnight accommodations, our member hotel for McHenry is the Hampton Inn, 815-578-1900.
